March 22, April 22, and May 18, 2020. This is an overview of the time the door of our church has been closed. During this time, we saw people finding creative ways to support and encourage one another across the globe. These included turning separating fences into picnic tables, gate to gate portable chair fellowships, On-line musicals and get together, and car parade birthday and anniversary celebrations.

Although many ministry personnel and church councils would like to open our doors, we are in agreement with the suggestions of Pacific Mountain Region (PMR) Council of the United Church of Canada.

MINISTER'S NOTE CONTINUES

The suggestion is that given the inherently social nature of Community of Faith events, the prolonged exposure of participants attending events, the demographics of our communities of faith as higher risk, and the safety protocols required to ensure reduced risk, PMR is not recommending having any worship service at this time. In their assessment, PMR noted that the risk does not outweigh the benefit of in-person gatherings at this time.

In addition, churches need to have a re-opening plan that spells out the provisions for a safe environment. Tenants or renters need to provide their safety plan before being allowed to use the building.

At St. Andrew's United Church, Enderby, we continue to reach out to our members to ensure that each member is connected and is reassured that they are not alone as a part of our Pastoral Care response.

I continue to work from the office on Wednesdays. This entails attending workshops, meetings, and any administrative task that is required on that day. I also use this time to connect with persons who drop by for conversation.

I continue to research and create my sermons that are sent out in the Messenger along with other information to inspire us as we practice social distancing. These sermons are posted Online and are streamed at respective service times. A big thank you to all those who provide music leadership, readings and prayers.

In these unusual times be patient, be loving, be kind, be gentle with yourself and others.

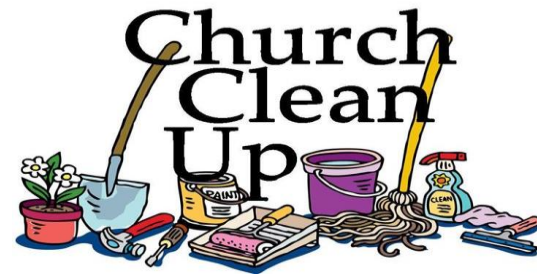
